Ephrata Area School District Receives Lancaster-Lebanon League Sportsmanship Awards

Ephrata Area School District recently received two recognitions by the Lancaster-Lebanon League. The District received the L-L League Spring Sportsmanship Award as well as the Overall Award for the 2017-2018 school year.

Every year, athletic directors across 24 school districts in Lancaster and Lebanon counties vote to award fall, winter, spring, and overall Sportsmanship Awards. Implemented in the 1999-2000 school year, the award aims to recognize schools that exemplify a high quality of sportsmanship during each sport season and throughout the entire school year. Additionally, individual sports teams receive similar sportsmanship recognition, which numerous Ephrata teams have received in previous years.

“We are grateful and humbled by this recognition from the L-L League. Mountaineer student athletes continue to make us proud in so many ways. While winning games may be what traditionally receives the spotlight, receiving the Spring L-L League Sportsmanship Award – and, most of all, the 2017-2018 Overall Award – proves the sportsmanship our students demonstrate does not go unnoticed and deserves to be commended.
