IMPORTANT REMINDERS - Be sure to

- Verify that the school(s) you are applying to require a Letter of Recommendation (LOR), as many schools do not use these letters in making enrollment decisions.
- Allow at least two weeks for your counselor/teacher to write this.
- Complete the Senior Brag Sheet and provide a copy to your teacher / counselor.

Teacher LOR

- Select a teacher that you feel knows you well, and can adequately write about your strengths.
- Ask the selected teacher if they would be willing to write this for you. Provide them with a copy of the Senior Brag Sheet.

Counselor LOR

- Provide your counselor with a copy of your Senior Brag Sheet.
- Counselors will complete letters of recommendation for all schools that you are applying to through the Common Application.
- Once your teacher(s) agree to writing a letter of recommendation, and after you have provided them with a copy of this sheet, you should log-in to Naviance to complete your request using the directions found on the Naviance website. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact your counselor.
