FISCAL ACCOUNTABILITY

Options that would help taxpayers ...and not eliminate options for students

OPTIONS TO ELIMINATE GROSS OVERCHARGING OF TAX-PAYERS:

- A. Price it the same as the virtual program offered by the district of residence
- B. Price it at a flat rate based on results of an annual audit and evaluation of program costs by PDE of the Cyber Charter
- C. Price it at a flat rate set annually by the government based on a general estimate of true costs of program instead of tying to district costs
- D. Apply the Special Education funding formula to those students who enroll in Cyber Charter
