Ephrata Summer Session 2021

- Ⓜ **Attendance:** Students are expected to be **in the classroom by 7:55 a.m. and/or 10:10 a.m.** Repeated tardiness will increase the chances of not passing the class(es).
- Ⓜ **Absences:** Regular attendance is required.
- Ⓜ **Online/Off-site:** Students working online will be required to use Microsoft Teams to be “present” during the sessions (at the direction of the classroom teacher). Students will be encouraged to be on-site, and will have to be approved for online work prior to the start of summer school. Limited availability exists for online / off-site work, and this option is based upon our capacity.
- Ⓜ **Food/drink:** Food or drinks are not allowed in the classrooms. If a student needs to eat or drink **between** classes, food or drink may be kept in a backpack or bag and given to the first period teacher until class is over. It may be consumed during class break.
- Ⓜ **Smoking/vaping:** Smoking/vaping on or near school property is a violation and will result in termination from summer school and possible prosecution.
- Ⓜ **Clothing:** Students are expected to dress appropriately for school.
- Ⓜ Students should only be in the halls where the summer classes are located or in the main hall if coming to the office. Students may not leave the sidewalk area in front at the entry area after they arrive at school.
- Ⓜ Disrespect will not be tolerated from students. All behavioral expectations of the normal school year are applicable during summer school. If the situation warrants a student’s removal from class, he/she can be terminated immediately from the program with no refund of payment.
- Ⓜ All student electronic devices will be placed in a container, on the student’s desk. However, they may not be used *in any manner* during class time. Cell phone infractions will be cause for dismissal.
- Ⓜ Any termination from summer school due to a rule infraction will result in forfeiture of all tuition.
