


Case Response Definitions

- Quarantine for Non-Household Contact
 - Please note that exposure date is Day 0


IF YOUR COVID-19 CONTACT DOES NOT LIVE WITH YOU



NON-HOUSEHOLD CONTACT

If you are able to live completely separate from the person in your house with COVID-19 follow the non-household contact timeframe.
Living separate from your housemate means no contact, no time together in the same room, and no sharing of any spaces such as a bathroom or bedroom.

ONE STEP
QUARANTINE FROM DATE OF LAST CLOSE CONTACT



REMAIN IN QUARANTINE THROUGH THIS DATE

Case Response Definitions

- Quarantine for Household Contact
 - Please note that most recent exposure date (end of case's infectious period) is Day 0. Household contact quarantines are 17-24 days.
